

## Changing Font Style & Color in D3

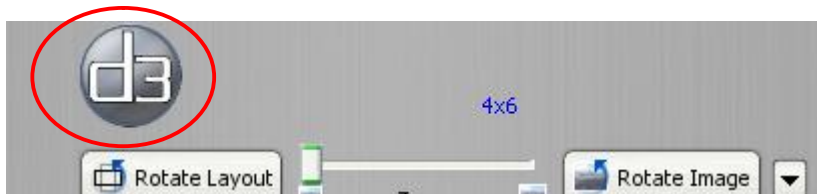

*This QuickTip shows how to change the font style and color of your custom-made text in D3.*

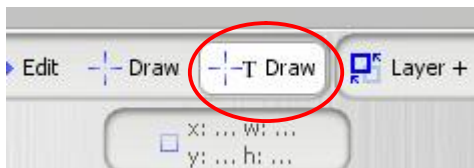
1. In onPrint, choose a D3-editable product.



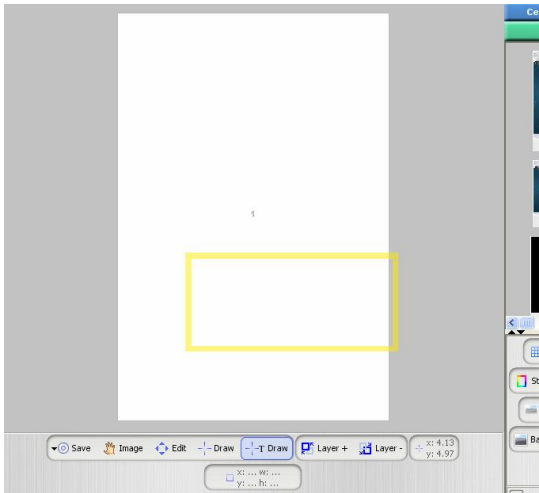
2. Click the D3 button to open the D3 Control Panel.



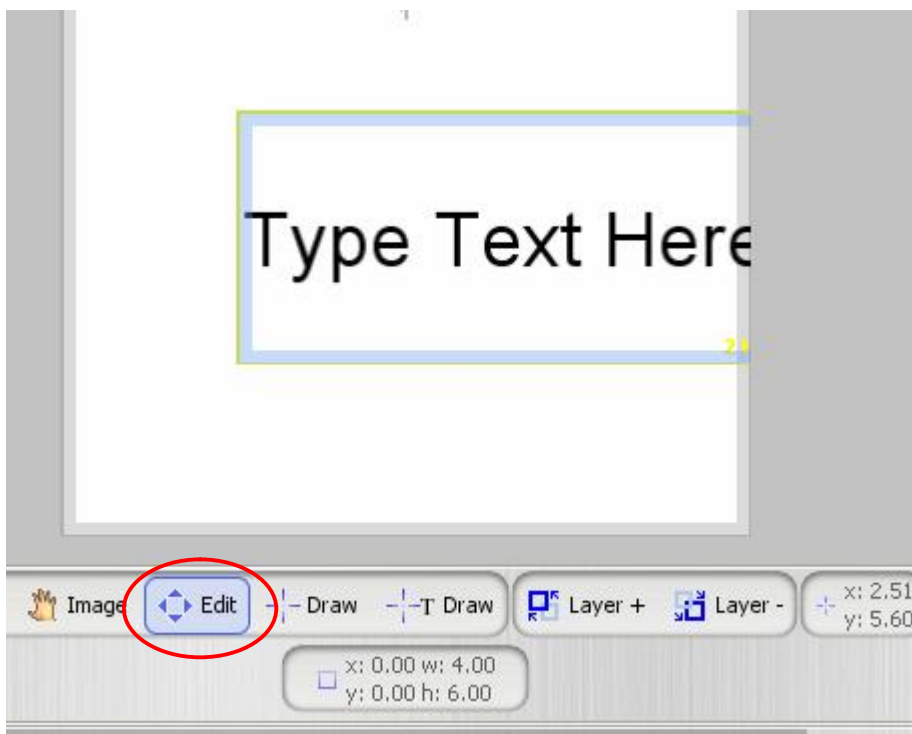
3. Click the "T Draw" icon beneath the image layout window.



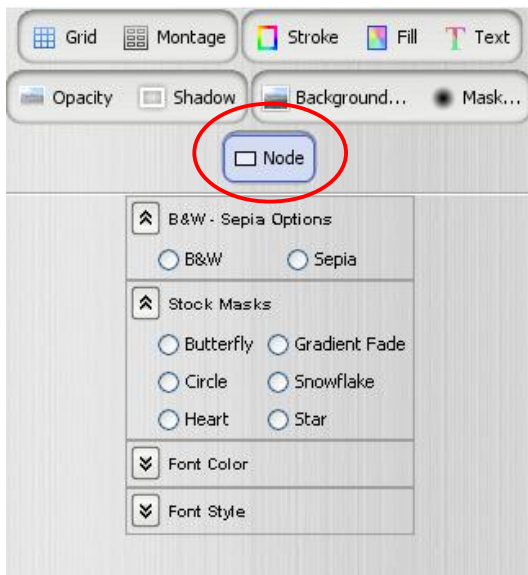
4. Single-click on the layout window while dragging your mouse to create a new node window.



5. Click the “Edit” button and then click on your new text node. The node should now be highlighted in blue.



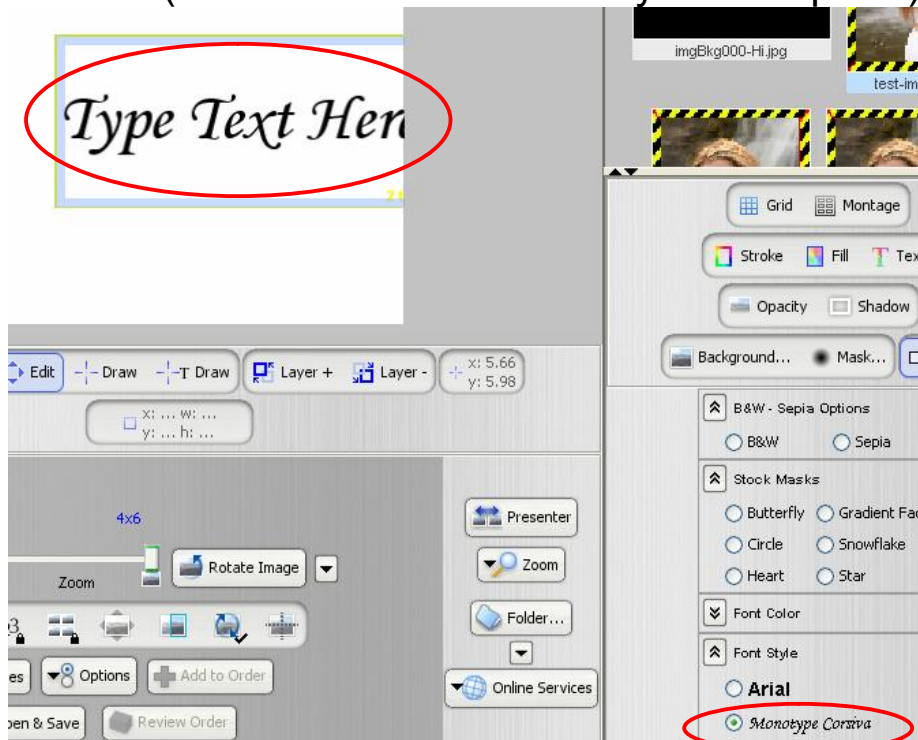
6. Expand the D3 Options window (below the thumbnail images) to view all options. Click the Node button to view all node options.



7. Click on the Font Style arrow to view all available font options.



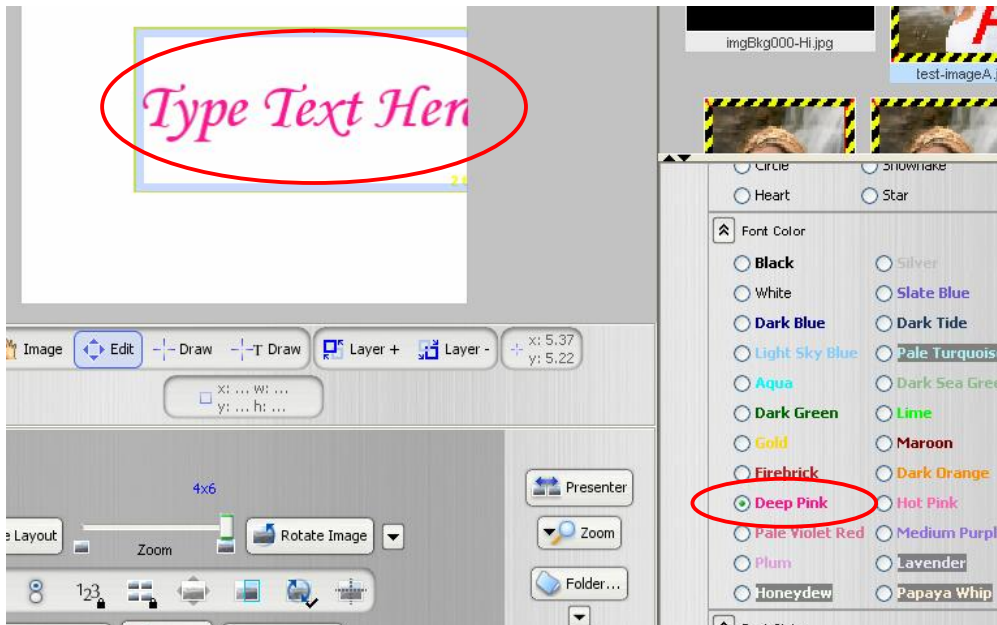
8. Select the new desired font. The new style shows in the layout window (if the font is installed on your computer).



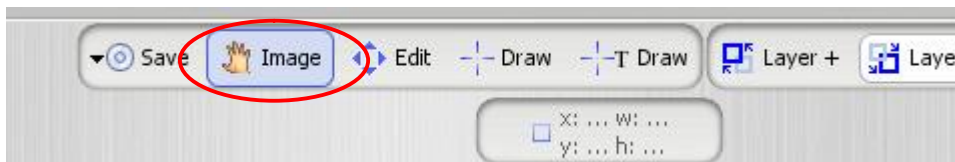
9. Change your font color by clicking the "Font Color" arrow and selecting a new color.



10. View the change to your font color immediately in the image layout window.



11. Click the "Image" button on the D3 control panel to commit your changes; add additional nodes as needed.



12. Be sure to save your work...click the Save button to name & save your new template.
